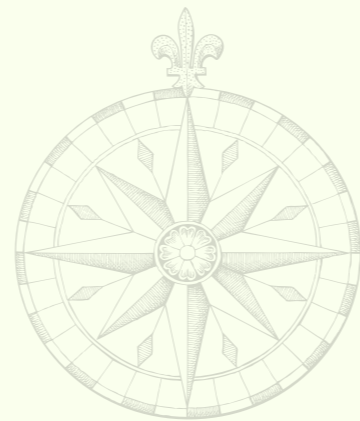




ATLANTIC-CARIBBEAN ISLANDS 2023/2024



This is sailor's paradise

Family Haynes with their Brigantine Florette will take you back in time to experience life as a pirate or explorer on the high seas. We will sail by beautiful rainforest and volcanic landscapes, and relax on white sandy beaches.

Our sailing area, the Greater –Lesser Antilles from Grenada in the south to the British Virgin Islands (BVI) in the north, is a string of islands that stretches over 600 nautical miles, about 1,000 km. The variety of mostly volcanic islands, the tropical climate, the flourishing nature and the almost constantly blowing north–east trade winds make these islands a sailing area par excellence. Nowhere else can you find such consistent wind conditions and such an impressive and diverse tropical nature.

Come experience all that this beautiful area has to offer on our historical tall ship!

There will be many factors that influence our day to day schedule. The wind that freshens up for a nice sail, the fish that is caught for the perfect evening BBQ, or we just fall in love with a quiet bay. We have allowed plenty of time to enjoy and appreciate the islands.

Below a few islands you may discover with us on one of our sailing legs.



The Green Island of Grenada is our most southern port. From here it is approx. 200 nautical miles along the Windward Island chain. Our voyages will start or finish in Barbados, Martinique, Grenada, Guadeloupe.

We will spend sailing the Grenadines. Tropical Caribbean Island Paradise with 32 islands partially uninhabited; shallow coral reefs, white sandy beaches lined with palm trees, and turquoise waters. The volcanic islands of Saint Vincent and Saint Lucia are also scheduled as stops.

Grenada:

Known as the “Spice Island” because all of the nutmeg plantations. The shorelines are covered in white-sandy beaches and the island is rich in lush green vegetation and wildlife.

Tobago Cays:

Visit this world famous marine protected area lined with white sandy beaches featuring many of the Caribbean’s finest snorkelling spots abundant with brightly coloured corals, sea turtles, stingrays, and tropical fish.

Bequia:

Experience a rich seafaring history and culture by roaming the markets in the charming seaside town of Port Elizabeth.

St Vincent:

Take a day to go hiking and chasing waterfalls in the La Soufriere National Park or have a quiet stroll through one of the oldest botanical gardens in the western hemisphere.

There is much to explore in St Vincent including the Pirates of the Caribbean movie set.

St. Lucia:

The majestic Piton mountains are a world heritage site (UNESCO) and their dramatic twin peaks make them one of the most famous and most photographed mountain pairs in the world.

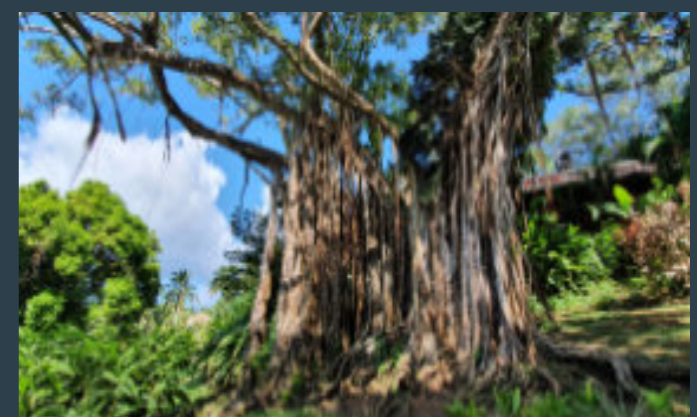
Reconnect with nature by hiking these peaks or walk the Tet Paul Nature Trail known as the ‘Gateway to Heaven’.

Martinique:

With it’s unique Creole Cuisine and Rum Agricole, this ‘Island of Flowers’ is a cultural must see.

Dominica:

Venture through the rainforest in this UNESCO World Heritage National Park whose dramatic landscapes are home to the Boiling Lake, Trafalgar Falls, Ti to Gorge, and Champagne Reef.



We continue our journey north sailing through the Leeward Islands. By this time we will have sailed almost 500nm from Grenada. With the remainder of the 30+ islands left for us to explore many new experiences and hidden gems await us.

Our voyages will start or finish in Antigua, St.Martin & Sint Maarten and Guadeloupe.

Antigua:

Home to 365 beaches and the iconic Nelson's Dockyard (UNESCO) and Shirley Heights, Antigua is definitely a place to have fun!

Kitts & Nevis:

This pair of islands offers everything from the impressive Brimstone Hill Fortress (UNESCO), a round of golf, to rum punches on the beach and impressive landscapes and tropical vegetation.

Sint Eustatius (Statia):

Priding itself with ecotourism (STENAPA), the Quill is home to over 35 endangered or rare species and is overgrown with tropical rainforest. The real treasure lies beneath the surface of the water though. Its protected Marine Park is a diver's paradise.

Saba:

This impressive volcano rises from the sea. Probably the reason that it was used as 'Skull Island' from the 1933 original King Kong movie. Unforgettable marine life is hidden below the waterline. Colourful corals, tropical fish, turtles and even sharks.

Mountserrat:

This 'Emerald Island' offers a reminder of nature's awe inspiring power with its active volcano that last erupted in 1995.

St. Barthelemy:

An escape destination for the rich and famous. Gustavia tiny streets are lined with posh boutiques and restaurants. Luxury yachts line the marina and the bays. The famous Nikki beach is a hotspot for beach goers and cocktails. \$\$\$

St.Martin & Sint Maarten:

The famous Maho beach where people flock to experience the famous airplane landing

Guadeloupe:

This diverse chain of islands offer a bit everything beautiful bays and picturesque beaches or for the more adventurous, a national park with an active volcano, waterfalls and 74,100 acre rainforest.

Embarkation: Your date of arrival & boarding time is 18:00.

Exact location will be determined on the day of arrival. You will be notified by mobile or by AIS (marine traffic on the internet).

We usally be at anchor or in a Marina. If your arrival is later than 1800 please let us know.

Disembarkation: your date of departure after breakfast at 09:00.

The prices does not include: passports or visas, travel insurance, any local taxes including departure and landing tax, personal clothing, medical expenses, items of a personal nature, drinks, alcohol and individual arrangements for travel to or from point of departure or arrival.

This prices does not include: land excursions, entrance fees into nature reserves, extra recreational fees including organised diving and snorkelling, extra harbour fees, and extra services.

Miscellaneous:

Each participant requires a passport that is valid for a minimum of 6 months before travelling, travel health insurance, and a medical certificate. You should be healthy and fit (see voyage crew form on our website), have visited a dentist before travelling, and have the necessary vaccinations.

You will receive the necessary voyage crew introduction & safety briefing, as well as a sailing and knot school on your first day on board. Our crew will be happy to provide you with professional guidance at all times.

We understand that the wind always has the last say. That's why we don't sail by a fixed plan or timeline - every day is unique and depends on the circumstances around us. Captain Ron Haynes has sailed all his life and has been the Captain of Florette for the past 25 years in the charter business. He with his family and crew will make sure your stay will be very special and unforgettable.

Depending on the sailing area, weather and location, a daily plan will be made. This will give you the opportunity to see the highlights and still be able to relax and enjoy.

We like to support the locals by using their excursions and enjoying their local foods. To give us more flexibility, we provide six meals per week on most voyages which we use best in our daily plans and charge extra if we feel we need more meals on board.

Although you will be embarking on an sailing voyage and the emphasis will be on your enjoyment of the experience, you will be on the vessel as a Voyage Crew Member.

Your role as a Voyage Crew Member will involve you learning about and participating in ship-board life. Allowances will be made for age and abilities. No previous sailing experience is necessary. The term "VOYAGE CREW" defines any persons coming onboard for pleasure and or as an active member of the permanent crew, trainee/ Mitsegler, youths or as a student.

Due to the nature of the ship and activities we require all Voyage Crew Members to be in good health and be fit. We want you to have fun!

Generally, we don't recommend this type of vacation to anyone who is 70 years or older. All seniors over 60 years during voyages in the Atlantic and Caribbean must have a letter of good health from a medical doctor stating they are fit to join the intended voyage.

Before all delivery voyages and Ocean sailings, we require all voyage crew to have an interview with Captain Ron Haynes to discuss if this type of voyage is suitable for you. Especially on longer voyages having a nice constellation of people on board is very important to us, as we will be living together in limited space for sometimes over a month.

The length of the voyage, the voyage crew constellation, and your age, experience and fitness will be considered. Of course, if you have sailed before with us you will be warmly welcomed on board.

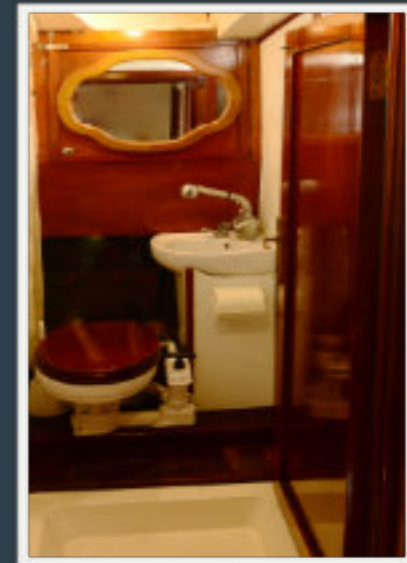
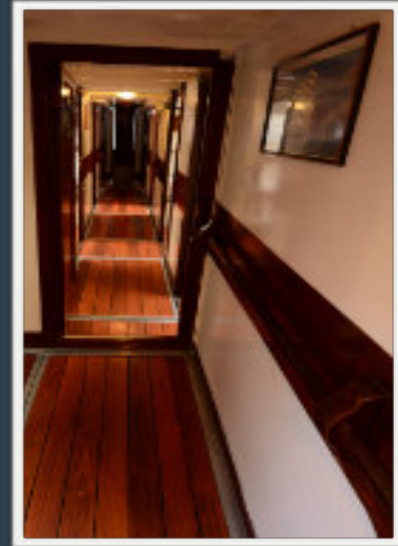
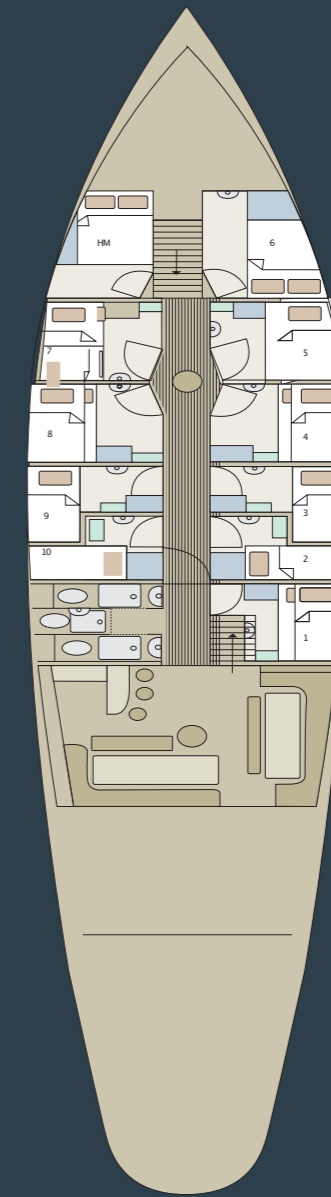
Is any person joining Florette between ages 13-25.

We have on some voyages special rates so young people and families can enjoy this adventure.

People joining under the age of 18 will have to fill out an extra form and have their parent's consent.

Also, in this case you will be required to have an interview with Captain Ron Haynes to discuss if this type of voyage is suitable for you. On certain voyages the cabin may be shared with their parents. Children under 12 years of age come on board for free.





Cabins

There are eleven double cabins on board. All cabins are equipped with running water, a 220V connection, a small table, a cabinet and a big deck hatch for fresh air and natural daylight. The cabins are equipped traditionally with bunk beds (without a ladder) or a small double bed. The beds have pillows, sheets and blankets. The ship has heating and air conditioning.

Cabin space

The total space is very generous for a maximum number of 27 guests. Nevertheless, the cabins and the sanitary facilities are very small compared to the ones on land. However, once you get used to the very compact design of the bathroom and toilet, you will wonder how such small a space can be used so well. Please note that there is minimal space in the cabin so please avoid bulky luggage like large suitcases.

Hammock sailor

The most authentic and economical way to sail with us is sleeping in a hammock. It's of course not as comfortable as our nice cabins. You will be supplied with a cotton hammock navy style which you can put up in the between 2100 hrs till 0730 hrs or when in a quiet bay at anchor on deck under the Stars.

You will also have a seaman chest for your personal belongings with a size of 80x50x45cm where you have to fit your belongings.

Apart from that, you enjoy the same good company and food. This offer is only available for people aged 30 years or younger. If the ship is not fully booked you may get lucky to upgrade to a shared cabin.
